The wire drawing industry is increasingly concerned about dust-related issues. With this in mind, Condat will present a paper and hold a training course on dust reduction during Interwire.

Thanks to its expertise, the company will give technical guidelines for the selection and use of the most suitable dry drawing lubricants, the objectives being to significantly reduce the amount of dust generated in the workshop and to improve productivity, while also reducing total wire-drawing costs.

Overall, the reduction of dust particles is central to lowering the exposure risk of operators and explosion hazards. It also reduces related maintenance costs and downtime.

The company will introduce its latest products dedicated to extra-high tensile steel cord wire production. These include a non-reactive surface coating booster for borax baths; and high-performance sodium soap-based dry drawing lubricants, including borax-free products.

These have been developed for high-speed drawing with low lubricant consumption and extended die life.

Condat will also present its new generation of lubricants for stainless steel and cold heading wire, all free from short and medium chain length chlorinated paraffins (short chain lengths are banned and medium chain lengths are subject to EPA regulations).

With an R&D laboratory of 45 people, and a large sales network of agents and distributors with high technical knowledge, Condat offers the wire drawing industry efficient lubricant solutions that meet the latest environmental, health and safety regulations.
